Convene

Presiding Commissioner John Grubaugh called the meeting of the County Commission to order at 9:00 a.m. on August 21, 2008 at the County Commission Office. Attendance: John Grubaugh, Present: Bill Barnett, Present: Tom Huff, Present. County Clerk, Kay Brown taking the minutes.

Motion/Vote - 9:00 a.m. Accept the Culvert Bid

Eastern Commissioner Tom Huff made a motion to accept the bid from Contech Construction Products, Inc. for the metal pipe and Advanced Drainage Systems, Inc. received the bid for the plastic pipe. In an emergency the county may purchase culverts from any local vendor. Bill Barnett seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: John Grubaugh (Yes), Bill Barnett (Yes), Tom Huff (Yes).

Right-of-Way Warranty Deed for 40th Street The Commission approved and signed the Right-of-Way Warranty Deed for 40th Street in Ozark, Missouri to transfer additional right-of-way along 40th Street to the Ozark Special Road District. The Grantor is CEO LLC., general partner is Richard Stowell. The deed was attested and signed by County Clerk, Kay Brown.

9:45 a.m. EMA- Amtower Re: Mapping Software Proposal

Those present for the meeting were Commission Secretary Julia Maples. The Commission met with Emergency Management Director, Phil Amtower to discuss a mapping software proposal. This software would be an extension of the GIS program. This is a certified software program that has a plug-in application which will enhance the functionality of the GIS system by creating a street index. Paula from the Nixa City Mapping Department offered her assistance to the Emergency Management Department to create an index if the county were to choose this software program. According to Mr. Amtower, this software creates different layers that could be used in printing maps.

Motion/Vote - 10:00 a.m. Proceed with a Map Logic Layout System

Eastern Commissioner Tom Huff made a motion to allow Phil the latitude to write a memorandum of understanding for the county to provide the software and the license for a map logic layout manager and Nixa will provide the technological support and labor for developing a road map with an index as well as a map book for the cities and the county. Bill Barnett seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: John Grubaugh (Yes), Bill Barnett (Yes), Tom Huff (Yes).


