Bid Opening - Bid Opening-Arapaho Bridge Repairs & Mayberry Road Project The meeting was attended by Commission Secretary Cheryl Mitchell, Jim Billedo, Brent Young, Rachel Smith, Jason Stutesmun, Travis Rapp and Steve Brown.

The Commission met with Great River Engineering Steve Brown and Travis Rapp to open bids for Arapaho Bridge. They received one bid from Joe Warren. The bid amount is \$65,207.25. Miranda asked Travis to explain. He said the slope is washed away exposing the pile. What they are gong to do is get the concrete pile to allow backfill into the bridge and allow the contractor to get the front even. They will award the bid Monday, August 17th.

Bids for Mayberry Road will be opened at 10:30 am.

The Commission met with Great River Engineering Steve Brown and Travis Rapp to open bids on the Mayberry road project. They received 2 bids. The first is Journagan for an amount of \$127,509.07. the second bis is from A.T. Urban for an amount of \$63,777.00. Miranda asked for explanation. Travis said it is a concrete slab and a straightforward job. Brent Young asked for the width. Steve Brown said the width is 20'. Great River will look over the bids and make a recommendation Monday, August 17, at 1:00 pm. Brent asked about any start dates. A.T. Urban said they could get on it pretty quick. Journagan said they could start as soon as they get the notice to proceed.

The first one is from Layer 3 Technology, Springfield MO., in the amount of \$ 18,180 per month. The second is from PC Solutions in the amount of \$41,400 for 2016 and through the end of 2015 is \$13,800. The third bid is from PC Net in the amount of \$6,450.00 per month. The last bid is from DaZZee in the amount of

\$6,800.00 per month with a standard rate of \$180 discounted to \$156.25 with a maintenance contract. The Sheriff will look over all the bids, assess what they have and make a decision Monday, August 17 at 1:30pm.
