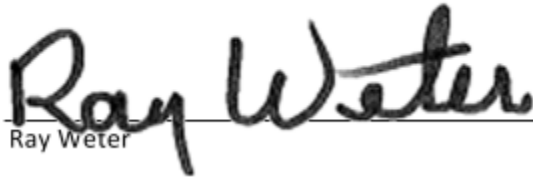

I, Kay Brown, Election Authority for the County of Christian, hereby certify the attached document to be a true, correct and complete abstract of all the votes cast in the Special Election for the Office of the Christian County Sheriff, that was held on August 4, 2015, as shown by the returns from all the different voting polling places or precincts in said city, and as verified by the recount election board as provided in 115.589 RSMo.


On Tuesday, August 25, 2015, a recount was performed for the Office of Christian County Sheriff beginning at 8:00 a.m. and ending at 12:30 p.m. The recount was held in the Christian County Clerk’s Office, conducted by twenty-eight disinterested registered voters that represented Christian County. The original MACHINE COUNT showed a difference of four votes cast between Brad Cole and Ralph Phillips.

The hand count for all the precincts showed an increase of two votes for a total count of 9,994 votes. The total votes cast of the recount are as follows:


