Commissioners reviewed three bids for provider of network management for Christian County. Factors considered in the decision included monthly fees, set-up fees, and discussion with other system users.

Presiding Commissioner Weter opened the floor to discussion.

Commissioner Childers said that every user should be on the same network system and after hearing feedback from users the sentiment was to award the contract to PC Net.

Contract - Scope of Services/Financial Commitment The meeting was attended by Assistant Nikki Thiessen, Assistant Ashley Hannah, Ben Sexton, Sheri Weter, Treasurer Karen Matthews, Auditor Lacey Hart, and Ron Pieracci.

Commission reviewed two proposals from Tyler Technologies for accounting software. The cost of technical support and implementation and manual versus automated conversion discussed. Software is licensed to site, not per individual, so County can add as many departments as necessary. Option One operates on existing Christian County servers at an annual cost of \$17,864.00, not including any minimal recurring fees for licensing. Option Two offered a six year subscription, including two onsite servers hosted by Tyler Technologies at annual cost of \$35,000.

Discussed travel expenses which would be additional cost during training. Tyler Technologies has support representative in O'Fallon, Missouri that would serve as the County's primary support. Per diem costs discussed should O'Fallon representative be unavailable.

Option and benefits of installing a receipt printer in the Treasurer's office discussed.

Treasurer Karen Matthews asked Ben Sexton how he feels about his prior working relationship with Tyler Technologies. Answer: Experience has been that company is responsive, fluid and smooth. He has never had issues with accessing a Tyler representative for assistance. Tyler Technologies will have the ability to remote into the County owned servers to provide support.

Ms. Matthews suggested a data-entry team be formed to input data to avoid confusion. Auditor Lacey Hart agreed.

Ms. Matthews then asked if a trial run could be performed with Tyler before a complete conversion to the new accounting program. Answer: Yes.

Discussion followed.

Commissioner Childers asked Ms. Hart if funds are available in the 2015 budget to write a check should a contract be signed before the end of year. Answer: Yes. Remaining cost of accounting software has been budgeted for 2016.

The Commission is interested in pursuing Option One with manual conversion. Mr. Pieracci recapped that proposal for a total cost of \$120,768.00, not including travel expenses. Twenty-five percent of the licensing fee is the only payment required up-front. The initial \$17,000 annual fee is waived for 90 days. Mr. Pieracci will promptly provide the Commission with a contract.

Presiding Commissioner Weter entertained a motion to enter into agreement with Tyler Technologies to provide software for accounting, payroll, and ancillary services for an initial investment cost of \$16,804.50, plus travel expenses up to \$15,000 pending final approval from Attorney John Housley.
