Donald Stewart presented documents related to the re-plat of Spokane Highlands performed in 2000. He is asking the Commission to void the re-plat.

Documents were reviewed by the Commissioners and discussion was held.

Presiding Commissioner Weter asked Mr. Stewart why he was bringing his request to the County Commission rather than present his case before the Court. Answer: He believes that it's within the right of the Commission to void the re-plat.

Presiding Commissioner Weter disagreed, saying that the Commission has no authority to make decisions over individual lot lines. Commissioner Barnett asked Todd Wiesehan for his opinion as the current Planning and Development Administrator. Answer: He believes that it is not the responsibility of the Commission to make this decision. Since the re-plat has been recorded, the issue should be taken in front of a judge.

Recorder Kelly Hall said that if she received a court order to vacate the re-plat then she would have to record that, making the re-plat void. At that time, the County Assessor can reassess the properties. Assessor Danny Gray agreed.

Mr. Stewart said he would consult with his attorney and thanked the Commissioners.

Presiding Commissioner Weter concluded with a statement that this was an administrative hearing only.




