Discussion - Plat Vacate-Sparta Industrial Park

Attendees: Krista Cronin, Cheryl Mitchell, Lindel R. Lipes, Patty Shilling with Styron & Shilling Law Firm, Amelia Wigton with the Christian County Headliner, Todd Wiesehan with the Planning & Development Department, and Sheena Elzie with KSPR News.

The County Commission met with Patty Shilling from Styron & Shilling Law Firm to discuss vacating Sparta Industrial Park. The presenters are Patty Shilling and Lindel Lipes. Ms. Shilling said Mr. Lipes developed the area in Sparta. The plan was to vacate a part of the plat and sell it as one parcel. As far as Ms. Shilling knows no one has any objection to it.

Presiding Commissioner Childers asked if it all sits inside Sparta city limits. Ms. Shilling said Sparta has no planning and zoning, therefore Christian County Commission has to approve the vacation of the subdivision.

Eastern Commissioner Childers asked, "By removing the plat, is it still commercial property?"

Ms. Shillings replied, "Yes".

Eastern Commissioner Childers asked Mr. Wiesehan if he can see a problem with the proposal.

Mr. Wiesehan recommended looking into it further, and said a written statement from the City of Sparta may be a wise thing to acquire.

Presiding Commissioner Weter said he was unsure about approving without assurances from John Housley, County Counselor. He'd like to assure that it's within the scope of Christian County's powers.

Presiding Commissioner Weter said Mr. Wiesehan has a comprehensive understanding of the subject matter, and wants him to consult with Mr. Housley. Eastern Commissioner Childers agreed that we need our County counselor to review this.

Ms. Shilling said she sent a proposed order along with a petition before this meeting to review.

Presiding Commissioner Weter said Mr. Housley should look over the petition, and asked Mr. Wiesehan if he could frame up something to give to Mr. Housley, to give him an idea.

Presiding Commissioner Weter said that we will review this matter on Tuesday, September 6, 2016, at 10:30 a.m.

Bid - MoDot Bid for County Salt Barns

Attendees: Krista Cronin, Cheryl Mitchell, Miranda Beadles with Christian County, and Amelia Wigton with the Christian County Headliner.

The County Commission met with Miranda Beadles to discuss bids for salt for the County Road District barns.

Miranda Beadles said since we are a government agency, we can piggyback on the Missouri Department of Transportation's existing fabric building annual contract. Ms. Beadles contacted the companies that won the bid from Southwest Missouri. Their bid for each building was \$59,020.00

Ms. Beadles said we have to prep our site, provide the asphalt pad and the concrete blocks. She said we have an annual contract for all those things at a third of the price that the other contractor would get it at.

Ms. Beadles then described the process of how the salt barns will work.

Presiding Commissioner Weter asked if acquiring the buildings would increase our salt capacity. Ms. Beadles said it would, by approximately 150 percent.

Ms. Beadles said we are stocked with salt at 100 percent right now, and have funds to buy more if we need it.

Eastern Commissioner Childers made motion to accept the Missouri Department of Transportation bid for approximately \$85,000.00
