The Commission met with Amber Bryant, Human Resources Director for Christian County to discuss the previously tabled approval of the Human Resources job description that has now been revised. Presiding Commissioner Ray Weter had no criticisms of the description, noting that Ms. Bryant will have a large task ahead of her; adding that this is quite ambitious. Eastern Commissioner Ralph Phillips apologized to Ms. Bryant as he felt many of the items could have been taken care of prior to her start with the County. He has read over the description several times and is complete agreement with it. Western Commissioner Hosea Bilyeu felt the job description was very well constructed, clear, and represents a period of change for the County. Ms. Bryant stated that this description is her goal for the County; knowing that developing and implementing a new department will not happen overnight.
