I have an item on Thursday's agenda for an amendment to our existing annual contract for roadway signs. The vendors have been in contact with us regarding the increase in aluminum costs and that they were unable to provide materials at the same price as bid in 2016. Per our contract, we can modify the existing through a formal contract amendment (see attached). We contacted each vendor and asked them to provide their new pricing for the duration of 2019. Also attached is a summary of the proposed pricing.

While we only have 5 months left on this contract if the amendment is approved, our sign purchases are typically large and I did not want to risk exceeding our limits set by State Statute.







2019 Annual Resurfacing Projects – C/S











CI, Chadwick Rd Improvements
