Presiding Commissioner Phillips entertained a motion to approve the consent agenda, which included the Christian County Commission's agenda for today, May 17th, 2021 as posted. Presiding Commissioner Phillips entertained a motion to enter into closed session per RSMo 610.021.19 (Security Systems). Western Commissioner Bilyeu moved to do so. Eastern Commissioner Morris seconded the motion.

Presiding Judge Johnson objected to closing the meeting and believes the exemption being utilized isn't appropriate and doesn't believe that the meeting qualifies under the definition of RSMo 610.021.19.

Western Commissioner Bilyeu explained that discussion may come up in closed session that would fall under the security statute. He said that he would like it noted that there is uncertainty in his mind, but he is deferring to those responsible for security in our facilities. Sheriff Cole noted that anytime you talk about access control to a secured facility it falls under closed session (security).

Presiding Commissioner Phillips said that we have the choice to continue with this meeting, or to postpose the meeting and consult with the County Attorney before resuming discussion.
