A quorum was established. Presiding Commissioner Phillips entertained a motion to approve the consent agenda which includes the Christian County Commission's agenda for today, August 16, 2021, as posted; Christian County Commission's regular session minutes dated July 29, 2021; and Christian County Commission's regular session minutes dated August 02,2021. The Commission met to review, discuss, and approve the IGA with the City of Ozark. The IGA is for a 50/50 cost share with any overruns concerning the sidewalk project around the square (around Historic Building).

Western Commissioner Bilyeu noted a question on the overruns and underruns, noting the agreement speaks about public improvements; asking if in the middle of the project, if the city wanted to make changes to the project that caused an increase in the cost to the County. He asked if the County had any control on change orders? Maintenance Supervisor Teague noted that Counselor Housley has reviewed the agreement and it was his understanding that the agreement was specifically concerning the sidewalk aspect of the project, but added that he did not like that there is no limit on the 50/50 cost share, he suggested a spending cap. Western Commissioner Bilyeu stated that his assumption will be that overruns will refer to areas of the project that relate to the County property and sidewalks not the entire project. Supervisor Teague added that he will be requesting to see all receipts on the concrete to keep an eye on the overruns.

Western Commissioner Bilyeu inquired who would be reaching out to the city? Presiding Commissioner Phillips stated he would reach out to Jeremy Parsons.

Presiding Commissioner Phillips entertained a motion to approve the IGA with the City of Ozark as presented. Eastern Commissioner Morris so moved. Western Commissioner Bilyeu seconded the motion.
