A quorum was established. There were two (2) items removed from the agenda, IT/Cyber Security Task Force and HR – Employee of the Quarter. Presiding Commissioner Phillips entertained a motion to approve the items listed on the consent agenda, which include approval of today's agenda (September 30th, 2021), which was posted in accordance with statute. Included in the consent agenda is the approval of previous meetings' minutes, to include closed session minutes per RSMo 610.021.1 (regarding litigation) from September 13th, 2021. The Commissioners met with Kay Brown, County Clerk and Paula Brumfield, Chief Deputy of County Clerk/Payroll Clerk for discussion of Paychex and Tyler payroll software. Discussion was held. It was stated the current software Paychex is not efficient, continual issues causing several hours of manual entry. Also noted was the change in cost of Paychex per person. Clerk Brown and Chief Deputy Brumfield request a change in software from Paychex to Tyler. Both were asked to get more information, a cost of analysis, as well as a list of pros and cons of both to present at a future meeting. No action was taken.

The Commission met with Purchasing Agent Kim Hopkins-Will for recommendation of award for ITB-2021-5 Assessment List Processing & Mailing for 2022. Of the three bids opened last week and reviewing, one bid (from Input Technologies) did not meet the minimum requirements on the bid specifications.
