INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR PURCHASE OF VEHICLES

**THIS INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT ("IGA") FOR THE PURCHASE OF POLICE VEHICLES IS MADE AND ENTERED INTO THIS 8<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2021 by and between the City of Battlefield, Missouri (hereinafter "City"), the Christian County Sheriff's Office (hereinafter "Sheriff") and the County Commission for Christian County, a political subdivision, (hereinafter "County").**

**WITNESSETH:**

**WHEREAS**, The City has two vehicles they can no longer use but are of use to another police agency: and

**WHEREAS**, The Sheriff has the need for two vehicles to maintain their current operational needs: and

**WHEREAS**, Both the City and Sheriff have similar needs and wants and can produce an agreement to make this exchange of funds for vehicles possible.

**WHEREAS**, The City has met the rotation schedule for both vehicles and the Battlefield Board of Aldermen has authorized the Police Chief to seek the removal of the two vehicles from the City's insurance list and active vehicle rooster.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual agreement set forth herein now, the City and the Sheriff agree as following:

**I. Effective Date & Purchase Price.**

Upon execution of this IGA by the City and Sheriff, the Sheriff shall pay the City **\$12,000.00** from the County Office for payment of the vehicles described below that are being sold "As Is" with title work:

2011 Chevy Tahoe VIN# **1GNSK2E09BR24650**

2015 Ford Interceptor VIN# **1FM5K8AR7FGA88293**

**II. Indemnification.**

Each party to this IGA shall protect, indemnify, and hold harmless the other parties and their respective officers, elected officials, employees, and agents from and against any and all liability, loss, expenses including attorney fees, or claims for injury or damages arising out of the performance of this agreement and resulting from the negligent or intentional acts or omissions of a party or that party's officers, elected officials, employees, and/or agents.

**III. General Independent Contractor Clause**

County, Sheriff, and the City are parties to this agreement are each separate and independent organizations and, as such County, Sheriff, and the City each retain their

own identity in providing services and each is responsible for its own polices and activities. County, Sheriff, and City shall be responsible for their respective employees, agents, and volunteers as to the duties or activities contemplated in this agreement. This agreement does not create a relationship other than Buyer/seller among the parties. It is the Parties intention the Sherriff will be the buyer and the City shall be the seller with the County being the financial party to the Sherriff. This Agreement shall not be construed as creating any other type of relationship between the County, Sheriff, and the City.

### **IV. Federal Contractor Provisions**

County, Sheriff, and City who are parties to this agreement agree to comply with all Provisions within all entities purchasing polices.

### **V. Entire Agreement**

This IGA represents the entire agreement of the parties, and any changes amendments or modifications hereto shall be contained in a writing signed by all parties.

### **VI. Counterparts**

This IGA may be executed simultaneously with its counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.

### **VII. Notices**

All notices, demands, consents, and approvals required under this Agreement may be personally delivered or sent by certified mail.
