

Christian County Commission Meeting

November 8, 2021 Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 8:25a.m., Hosea Bilyeu, Western County Commissioner, presiding due to the absence of Presiding Commissioner, Ralph Phillips.

Acting Secretary and Eastern County Commissioner, Lynn Morris, called for quorum ~~vote~~ with Bilyeu and Morris present.

Morris made a motion to approve the consent agenda, Bilyeu seconded. Vote 2 to 0, yes.

One financial – Roads and Bridges certified court order 11 -09-2021-01 was approved.

County Clerk, Kay Brown, gave a report of the November 2, 2021 election certification. Voter turnout was higher than expected in Nixa with the Recall of the Nixa Mayor failing. Voters in Highlandville passed both ballot initiatives including the Use Tax Proposal. Saddlebrook failed by one vote, rejecting the Use Tax Proposal. Morris made a motion to approve the certification of the election results and Bilyeu seconded, passing 2 to 0, yes.

Amber Bryant, HR, discussed the holiday schedule for the year 2022 with an additional holiday created by the federal government for June 19th which will be added to the county holiday schedule. Morris made a motion to approve the 2022 holiday schedule and Bilyeu seconded, passing 2 to 0, yes.

Amy Dent, Auditor, presented the 2022 budget for the prosecuting attorney's office, which can be reviewed in the next 10 days either online or there will be a copy in the commissioner's office. She went over the county 2022 budget so it can also be reviewed over the next 10 days either online or by reviewing a copy in the commissioner's office. The auditor was able to format and tab each department's budget for easier review.

The open session recessed at 8:55 a.m. to continue to closed session with Amy Dent, Auditor.

The commission resumed from recess at 9:45 to continue the meeting with Brad Cole, Sheriff. He gave a report on the IGA for purchase of two vehicles from the city of Battlefield for \$12,000 dollars total. The two cars have 50,000 and 60,000 miles respectively which the group considered a good buy. Morris made the motion to approve the IGA and Bilyeu seconded with a count of 2 to 0, yes.

Morris made a motion to adjourn, Bilyeu seconded and the meeting adjourned at 10a.m.
