A quorum was established. Presiding Commissioner Phillips entertained a motion to approve the items listed on the consent agenda, which include approval of today's agenda (February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022) which was posted in accordance with statute. Minutes presented for regular session of January 25<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Financials presented to include a failed transfer switch at the Jail with an estimated cost of \$5,738.87 (Central Systems and Services), courtyard landscaping with an estimated cost of \$3,067.25 (Springfield Gardens), courtyard trees with an estimated cost of \$3,625.00 (Springfield Gardens), courtyard concrete planters with an estimated cost of 12,804.40 (Springfield Gardens) and a snow blower with an estimated cost of \$2,000.00 (Lofton).
