Presiding Commissioner Phillips entertained a motion to approve the consent agenda, which includes approval of today's agenda, and approval of regular session minutes from October 11th, 2022.

Eastern Commissioner Morris made the motion to approve. Western Commissioner Bilyeu seconded the motion.

Aye: Presiding Commissioner Phillips, Western Commissioner Bilyeu, and Eastern Commissioner Morris.

Motion passed.

The Commissioners met with presenter Kay Brown, County Clerk, regarding the MAC Delegate Election. We had 100% participation of all the elected officials. Two delegates will need to be on the MAC Board of Directors for 2023; one of the Commissioners will serve on that board this year. Presiding Commissioner Ralph Phillips will serve on this board. Eastern Commissioner Lynn Morris and Western Commissioner Hosea Bilyeu broke the lock and tallied the votes for the MAC Delegation. There was a tie, with six votes for Brad Cole and six for Kelly Hall. We will hold a new election, which will end at noon on Friday this week.

Presiding Commissioner Phillips entertained the motion to hold another election; Western Commissioner Bilyeu made the motion, and Eastern Commissioner Morris seconded the motion. Aye: Western Commissioner Bilyeu, Eastern Commissioner Morris, and Presiding Commissioner Phillips

The Commissioners met with presenter Brad Cole, Sheriff, regarding the Show Me Zero Grant. We have a grant application submitted to Missouri Coalition for roadway safety. This grant has been awarded to us. The initiative is to promote highway safety. This grant is for four thousand two hundred thirty-two dollars and fifty-four cents. This is for promotional items that we will hand out at community events to promote roadway safety. This is at no cost to the county.

Presiding Commissioner Phillips entertained the motion to approve the Show Me Zero Grant presented by Sheriff Cole; Eastern Commissioner Morris made the motion, and Western Commissioner Bilyeu seconded the motion.

The commissioners met with presenter Brad Cole, Sheriff, regarding the Northern and Middle States Rural Law Enforcement Training and Technical Assistance Grant Program. The sheriff has another grant from the National White Collared Crime Program and has been awarded five thousand nine hundred forty-eight dollars and sixty cents. It's a nonmatching grant and is fully funded by NW3C. This will be for purchasing ten new mobile data terminals. There will be no cost to the county.

Presiding Commissioner Phillips entertained the motion to approve the grant presented by Sheriff Cole. Western Commissioner Bilyeu made the motion, and Eastern Commissioner Morris seconded the motion.

The Commissioners met to discuss the 2023 Holidays. We are adding the day after Thanksgiving. We will observe 14 holidays in total for the year.

Presiding Commissioner Phillips entertained the motion to approve; Western Commissioner Bilyeu made the motion that we approve the dates provided by the Supreme Court of Missouri with the addition of the day after Thanksgiving for the Holidays for 2023, and Eastern Commissioner Morris seconded the motion.

The commissioners met with presenter Croley Insurance regarding the 2023 Group Health Renewal. This discussion is about our employee benefits and group health care. This past year has been one of the better claims data years we have had. The original renewal with cox, with a rate cap, came in at 8.5%. We did get a verbal quote from the 3rd party administrator, of which the renewal might come in at around 6%. We took that data to Cox Health, and they came back and gave us a revised renewal of 5.9%. The renewal itself is on January 1st. HR would like to have a conversation with the third-party administration firm. This renewal with Cox that was released is good till the end of the year.
