The motion failed for lack of a second. Commissioner Bilyeu made a motion that the ballot language should read like this "Shall Christian County, Missouri impose a countywide sales tax of three percent (3%) on all tangible personal property retail sales of non-medical adult use marijuana sold within Christian County, Missouri" Presiding Commissioner Morris seconded the motion.
