Presiding Commissioner Morris entertained a motion to approve the consent agenda, which includes approval of today's agenda, approval of regular session minutes from March 14th, 2023. We are removing the Court Order from the agenda.

Presiding Commissioner Morris entertained a motion to approve the consent agenda as stated. Western Commissioner Bilyeu made the motion, Eastern Commissioner Jackson seconded the motion.

The Commissioners met with presenter Miranda Beadles regarding the Variance Request – Hope Lane. A couple of weeks ago, we met with some of the property owners of Hope Lane. This is located in Common 1. The road has not been maintained by the property owners in the past 12 years. Two weeks ago, when everyone met, Miranda provided a bullet list of items they would need to meet the standard if they were required to meet the standards that were in place at the time of their platting and road building. Essentially they are requesting a variance from the current standards that are in place today. They are here today to request that variance. Andy tried to work with Miranda off and on throughout the years to try and figure out what happened with the road. We need your help. This would make a huge difference in our quality of life for us. We hope that you will grant this variance. Lynn thinks this is going to be a good thing for the county and a good thing for Hope Lane. Five residents live on this road, and each will pay their fair share for this project.

Presiding Commissioner Morris entertained a motion to approve the variance, as Miranda has stated. Western Commissioner Bilyeu made the motion that we grant the variance that has been placed before us related to Hope Lane. The rationale for that is that it is a unique situation, wherein the timing of the initial construction of the road, in combination with nationwide economic recession conditions impacting the new housing market, created an undue hardship preventing the developer from meeting the County's requirements in place at the time calling for at least seventy-

five percent (75%) occupancy before the County could accept the road for perpetual maintenance. The variance will exist for one year from this date. Eastern Commissioner Jackson seconded the motion.

The Commissioners met regarding the Show Me Christian County Discussion on Recreational Marijuana.
