Work Study was held to discuss the application process for the Christian County Library board selection process, application and advertising the two open positions the end of June.

Ozark Area – Cassidy, Riverside, West Finley, East Finley, McCracken and Linden

South County – North Galloway, South Galloway, Saddlebrook, North Linn and South Linn

Applications are accepted for positions year-round.

Commissioner Lynn Morris likes the current application process; has a few more questions he would like to add to the current application. Commissioner Bradley Jackson added to the application questions from the Henry County, KY Library Board application. Bradley Jackson would like for the application to be uploaded to the county and library website as a PDF form for applications to print off and hand write before submitting.

Commissioner Hosea Bilyeu would like to have someone from each township on the board but will accept and interview the best qualified applicants.

Openings for Library Board are advertised by the Library on their social media pages, branch message boards, website and newsletters. Christian County Headliner said they would put out a publication, as well, for the current openings.

Commissioners asked if the current Library Board members were okay with advertising the current openings for two weeks instead of thirty days so they could select two people before July board meeting – board is okay with suggestion.


The library board currently does open interviews – The commission will be voting on doing one on one interviews during the next meeting. The commission will also vote on additional application questions.
