Motion passed.



Everything we do for employees comes from elected officials or HR's pockets. We could use Glenn Candy company for a 6-month trial to see if we sell enough products to make it year-round. As far as food trucks, we can get two different ones for food. We would try to get Christian County food trucks two days a week. Maybe we charge a rental fee or a percentage of what's sold. They


would need to be insured. Court day would be the best day to have food trucks. Eastern Commissioner Jackson and a couple of other people will be the point person on this.
