Items to be removed from the consent agenda:

Presiding Commissioner Morris entertained a motion to approve the consent agenda, which included Christian County Commission's agenda for today, September 19, 2024, as posted, Christian County Commission's regular session minutes dated September 12, 2024, and one financial, Certified Court Order No. 09-19-2024-01. Eastern Commissioner Jackson so moved. Western Commissioner Bilyeu seconded the motion.

The Commission met with Purchasing Manager Kim Hopkins-Will for renewal of RFP #2023-17 Material Hauling Services for the Recycle Center. This is the first renewal of this RFP, to Republic Services.

Presiding Commissioner Morris entertained a motion to approve the renewal of RFP #2023-17 Material Hauling Services to Republic Services. Western Commissioner Bilyeu so moved. Eastern Commissioner Jackson seconded the motion.

The Commission met with Highway Administrator Miranda Beadles for a contract award on Fern Rd. and Columbine Rd. improvements – also know as the Bull Creek Basin Drainage Improvements. This is part of the larger County-wide storm water improvement project funded by ARPA.

Presiding Commissioner Morris entertained a motion to approve the award for the Bull Creek Basin Drainage Improvement project (Fern Rd. & Columbine Rd. Improvements) to TJS Excavating. Eastern Commissioner Jackson so moved. Western Commissioner Bilyeu seconded the motion.

The Commission met with Highway Administrator Miranda Beadles for an update on County infrastructure projects. Administrator Beadles reviewed all active and proposed projects across the County, discussion was held, no action was taken.

The Commission met with Garrison Special Road Commissioners, Tim Stepp & Raymond Stevens regarding funding of the road district and the sales tax distribution program. Commissioners Stepp & Stevens both relayed that their district was lacking funding after an investigation that was initiated over 4 years ago and due to the lack of funding, they're unable to properly maintain their roads, they also stated they had two bridges facing possible closure without funding. Discussion was held. The Commissioners agreed to look deeper into this concern working with the Auditor and Treasurer and to plan a possible work study session. No action was taken.


The Commission had no communications to discuss.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:17 a.m.




