### Announced Projects Since January 2025

- **Capital Holding Group** (started May 2024): Expansion announced for a new asphalt plant on its existing property in Christian County.
  - This **\$29.5M investment in Christian County** will create **29 new jobs** at higher than average county wage
  - For every \$40,000 paid in salaries in the asphalt plant industry in Christian County, an additional \$116,400 will be spent in the local community.
  - For every \$40,000 in sales/output from this asphalt plant, an additional \$4,400 will be spent in the local community.
- **Children's Smile Center** (started August 2022): Children's Smile Center has officially broken ground on its new facility in Nixa.
  - This **\$3.5 million investment** will allow the nonprofit to expand care for children on Medicaid.
  - The new clinic will **create 7 new jobs**. For every 3 new jobs created in a dental office, 1 other new job will be created in a different industry within the community. Therefore from this development 9.3 jobs will be created.
  - For every \$40,000 paid in salaries within the dental industry, \$8,400 will be spent in the local community.
- **Ozark Marketplace** (started May 2022): 26 Acre Retail Development in Ozark.
  - \$17.5M development will be a retail destination - Potential tenants include Aldi, McDonald's, Plaza Tire, Casey's, and Dutch Brothers Coffee. There are 9 lots available/unannounced.
  - County's portion of sales tax revenue estimated to be \$2.028 annually at full build-out
  - County's property tax revenue projected to increase from \$93 total over 25 years to \$91,849 total
