The Commission met with Recorder Kelly Hall for her Office's 2nd Quarter Report. Discussion was held; no action was taken.

The Commission met with Highway Administrator Miranda Beadles for the Highway Department's 2nd Quarter Report. Discussion was held; no action was taken.

The Commission met with Highway Administrator Miranda Beadles for a contract award of annual engineering services. 10 submittals were received and 6 were selected to be awarded; today 4 will be awarded as contracts for Great River Engineering and Olsson are not yet received. Discussion was held.

Presiding Commissioner Morris entertained a motion to award the contract for annual engineering services to CJW Transportation Consultants LLC, Own, Inc., Shaffer & Hines, Inc., and Wilson & Company, Inc. Western Commissioner Williams so moved. Eastern Commissioner Jackson seconded the motion.

The Commission met with Highway Administrator Miranda Beadles to discuss county maintenance on US Forest Service Roads. Currently the County maintains 33 whole or partial service roads in the Common 1 road district and some of the service agreements are set to expire at the end of 2026. Administrator Beadles noted that the Commission will need to decide to renew these agreements or relinquish them back to USFS for maintenance. Discussion was held; no action was taken.

The Commission met with Highway Administrator Miranda Beadles for a project award for Keltner Road slab #2. 3 bids were received; J&H Excavating, AT Urban Development, and D&E Plumbing & Heating. The lowest and best bid was from AT Urban Development. Discussion was held.

Presiding Commissioner Morris entertained a motion to award the project award of Keltner Road slab #2 to AT Urban Development as presented. Eastern Commissioner Jackson so moved. Western Commissioner Williams seconded the motion.

The Commission met for County Board Updates. Western Commissioner Williams noted that 3 boards need to have reappointments on the record. The Law Enforcement Restitution Fund Board (LERF) has 3 members to be reappointed; The Sheriff is reappointing Susie Ballard and Robert Seiner; the Coroner reappointed Josh Barton. Their terms will begin August 01, 2026, and expire July 31, 2028

Senate Bill 40 (CC Links) has three members to reappoint; Greg Williams, Tiffany Eggleston, and Amanda Barnes-Adams. Their new terms will begin August 01, 2026, and expire July 31, 2029.

The Senior Citizens Service Fund Board has two members to reappoint; Rick Johnson and Linda Daugherty. Their terms will begin August 01, 2026, and expire July 31, 2030.

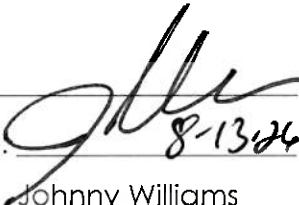
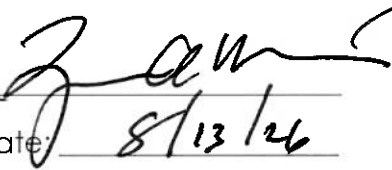
