A Resolution to Demonstrate Christian County, Missouri's Commitment to Public Safety and Crime Reduction

Whereas, the safety and well-being of all residents, visitors and businesses within Christian County, Missouri are of paramount importance; and

Whereas, crime poses a significant threat to the quality of life, economic growth and overall health of the community; and

Whereas, a collaborative approach involving law enforcement, community organizations, residents and other Stakeholders are essential to effectively reduce crime.

Now, Therefore, be it resolved by the Commission of Christian County, Missouri as follows:

Section 1. Commitment to Public Safety. Christian County reaffirms its commitment to the safety and security of all residents and will prioritize public safety initiatives in its policies, budgets, and programs in an effort to reduce and eliminate crime.

Section 2. Strategic Crime Reduction Efforts. Christian County shall maintain a crime reduction strategy that includes:

- Continuing community-based policing to strengthen trust and cooperation between law enforcement and residents.
- Investing in crime prevention programs, including youth engagement, special enforcement projects, local coalitions and training.
- Enhancing the use of technology and data-driven approaches to identify and address crime trends.
- Focusing on the reduction and elimination of violent crime.

Section 3. Community Engagement. The County will continue to engage community members in public safety initiatives and collaborative efforts to maintain transparency.

Section 4. Equitable Resource Allocation. The County shall ensure that public safety resources are distributed equitably, addressing the needs of the community.

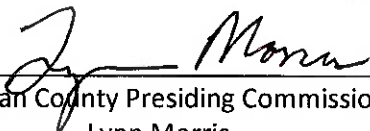
Section 5. Measuring Progress. The County will establish measurable goals for crime reduction and public safety.

Section 6. Advocacy and Partnerships. The County will advocate for state and federal funding to support crime prevention and public safety initiatives.

Section 7. The Christian County Commission calls upon all residents, businesses, and institutions to work together in a shared commitment to fostering a safe, thriving, and resilient community.
