



**ADDENDUM TO THE AUGUST 2023 ORDER OF THE CHRISTIAN COUNTY
COMMISSION REGARDING SPECIAL EVENT PERMITS**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Revised Statutes of Missouri, the Christian County Commission (the “Commission”), has authority to regulate Special Events within the County;

WHEREAS, the Commission previously passed Order No. 03-05-07-1 requiring individuals or entities to apply for a Special Event Permit for any qualifying event;

WHEREAS, the Commission amended Order No. 03-05-07-1 on or around August 11, 2023 to provide enhanced penalties for failure to comply with its requirements, and to clarify the deadlines for obtaining a Special Event Permit; and

WHEREAS, the Commission believes additional provisions are needed to address the public demand for permits, and to streamline the process and procedures for obtaining permits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF CHRISTIAN COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Christian County Order No. 03-05-07-1 remains in full force and effect, except as amended and supplemented by the August 11, 2023 Order.
2. The August 11, 2023 Order remains in full force and effect, except as amended and supplemented by this Order.
3. Henceforth, Special Events Permits shall be categorized as Single-Use and Multiple-Use Special Event Permits.
4. Approved Single Use Special Event Permits allow the applicant to hold a single event as specified by the terms and conditions of the permit.
5. Approved Multiple Use Special Event Permits allow the applicant to hold multiple events within the calendar year as specified by the terms and conditions of the permit.

6. The calendar year begins on the New Year's Day of the given calendar system and ends on the day before the following New Year's Day and thus consists of a whole number of days.
7. Applicants for Single-Use and Multiple-Use Special Event Permits shall follow and comply with the policies and procedures established by the previous Special Event Permit Orders except:
 - A. Multiple-Use Special Event Permit Applicants shall provide the Christian County Emergency Management office with the calendar year list of events and the information required for each of the events to the extent possible at the time of filing.
 - B. Multiple-Use Special Event Permit Applicants shall update the Christian County Emergency Management office as soon as relevant information becomes available for each event to ensure authorities are properly prepared for each event.
 - C. If a Multiple-Use Special Event Permit Applicant would like to schedule an additional event after submitting the original application, the applicant must follow and comply with the policies and procedures established for Single Use Special Event Permits.
 - D. For an event to proceed as permitted, Multiple-Use Special Event Permit Applicants shall have all necessary and required information for the event to the Christian County Emergency Management office at least thirty (30) days prior to the event to ensure compliance with Permit requirements.
 - E. If and/or when changes to the information provided are needed for Single-Use or Multiple-Use Special Event Permit applications after the thirty (30) day deadline, those changes shall be brought to the attention of the Christian County Emergency Management office as soon as an applicant is aware of the need for a change so that the authorities may assess and approve or halt the event from proceeding as planned.
 - F. Should changes in event information after the thirty (30) day deadline negatively impact, alter, or adversely affect the performance of the event as permitted, the Christian County Emergency Management office may cancel or postpone the event as necessary to protect public welfare and safety.

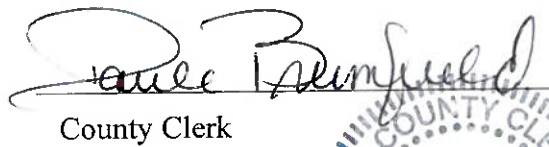

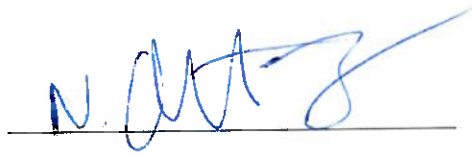
