ORDER OF DISCHARGE

On consideration of Plaintiff's verified Petition in Interpleader, the Court finds that it has jurisdiction of Plaintiff's claims, and that Plaintiff is or may be subject to multiple recovery for what is actually a single liability, interpleader is the appropriate action, and the Court further finds that all persons having such claims have been joined and should be required to interplead. Accordingly, it is

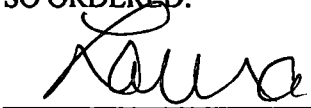
ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED as follows:

1. The named Defendants have either waived any objection or not otherwise timely asserted any objection to Plaintiff's request in its Petition in Interpleader that the funds be interpleaded and that Plaintiff be discharged from liability.
2. This Court accepts jurisdiction of Plaintiff's Petition in Interpleader and assumes jurisdiction of the funds tendered by Plaintiff into Court. The Clerk of the Court is ordered to deposit the interpleaded funds into a separate, interest bearing account during the pendency of this action.
3. Plaintiff is hereby ordered discharged from any and all liability with respect to this cause.
4. The attorney's fees and costs submitted by Plaintiff are reasonable and necessary and the Clerk of the Court is hereby ordered to pay to Lowther Johnson Attorneys at Law, LLC, the sum of \$2,935.85 out of the sum heretofore paid into the registry of the Court, as and for attorney's fees and costs.
5. Defendants Derrick Bryton Alling and Roger K. Sweet, as Personal Representative of the Estate of Carolyn Alesia Alling, are hereby ordered to file their claims to the interpleaded funds.
