A RESOLUTION OF THE (LOCAL GOVERNING BODY/SCHOOL DISTRICT/SPECIAL DISTRICT) ADOPTING THE ST. LOUIS REGIONAL ALL-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN (UPDATED 2015)

WHEREAS the (*local governing body/school district/special district*) recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within the (*local governing body/school district/special district*); and

WHEREAS the (*local governing body/school district/special district*) has participated in the preparation of a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as the *St. Louis Regional All-Hazard Mitigation Plan (Updated 2015)*, hereafter referred to as the *Plan*, in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS the *Plan* identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in the (*local governing body/school district/special district*) from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS the (*local governing body/school district/special district*) recognizes that land use policies have a major impact on whether people and property are exposed to natural hazards, the (*local governing body/school district/special district*) will endeavor to integrate the *Plan* into the comprehensive planning process and

WHEREAS adoption by the (*local governing body/school district/special district*) demonstrates their commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the *Plan*

The participating jurisdiction acknowledges that adoption of the Plan demonstrates its commitment to the mitigation goals, strategy, and implementation processes described therein. Adoption of the Plan does not, by itself, obligate the jurisdiction to fund or complete every mitigation action identified in the Plan. Implementation of individual actions remains subject to applicable authorities, priorities, available resources, funding, and other implementation considerations.

The participating jurisdiction acknowledges and affirms that their involvement is driven entirely by a shared commitment to the safety, well-being, and resilience of the local governing body/school district/special district through proactive hazard mitigation.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE (LOCAL GOVERNMENT/SCHOOL DISTRICT/SPECIAL DISTRICT), in the State of Missouri, THAT:

Section 1.
